

Terms and Conditions

Rights

SIRC grants the Subscriber and authorized users at the Subscriber's institution the right to access the electronic version of those journal volumes for which the Subscriber maintains an electronic subscription.

It is a condition of receiving access to the electronic journals that any person who violates either the copyright or the restrictions on distribution, or who condones such acts, may be deprived of future access, including access to back issues, without compensation or refund, while SIRC retains the further right to any legal remedies that may be available.

Authorized Users

Authorized users of an institutional membership are defined as employees, faculty, and students of the Subscriber and an individual subscription is limited to the individual whose name appears on the membership.

Usage Restrictions

The Subscriber and authorized users may view, print, and download single copies of articles or other content for personal use.

The Subscriber and authorized users may not make copies for general distribution, for advertising or other promotional purposes, for creating new collective works, or for any resale purpose such as document delivery. For such copying, separate agreements must be made with the copyright owner. The Subscriber will notify all authorized users of permitted and prohibited use, and the Subscriber will take any corrective action necessary against authorized users who contravene these conditions.

Copyright

As a library, document supplier, and publisher, SIRC has strict copyright policies. Fees and Payments

(a) You can always find the current Subscription Fees and charges posted under My Account on the SIRC Web site. Your subscription will continue and renew automatically unless terminated by SIRC or until You notify SIRC of Your decision to change Your subscription renewal. For cancellation instructions, log in to your account and click the Billing Information section of your My Account page. If there are any annual, monthly or similar periodic fees for Your subscription, these fees will be billed automatically to the credit card designated during the registration process, or subsequently designated to SIRC at the start of the subscription period and at the start of each renewal period, unless You terminate Your subscription before the relevant period begins. You agree to pay or have paid all fees and charges incurred in connection with Your subscription for SIRC Membership (including any applicable taxes) at the rates in effect when the charges were incurred. SIRC may change the fees and charges then in effect, or add new fees or charges, by giving You notice in advance. All fees and charges incurred in connection with Your user name and password will be billed to the credit card designated during the registration process for SIRC Membership or subsequently designated to SIRC. (e) Subscription Renewals. Your SIRC subscription will be automatically renewed unless you change your selected subscription option prior to the end of your current subscription period. Your subscription options are located under My Account on the Billing Information page. For your convenience, we will bill the subscription fee to the credit card you provided to us during registration (or to a different credit card if you make a change to your account information). Please contact us if you need assistance in updating your subscription options, making a change to your plan or if you need to request a refund.

Circulation and Loan

The SIRC Resource Centre is a public use library. Materials may be used at designated reading spaces, or photocopied onsite for personal educational use. Any materials not found in open stacks (in storage) may be requested via the SIRC Reference staff. Borrowing privileges are available to SIRC members only. Please contact SIRC for membership information.

Onsite Patrons: SIRC Members and the public are allowed unlimited use of materials within the Resource Centre. Books may only be borrowed from the Resource Centre by SIRC members.

SIRC Members: Up to 5 items may be checked out of the Resource Centre at a given time. When the loan limit is reached, the Library Catalog will block further loans until the borrower has returned materials. Members are responsible for pick-up and return of all materials.

Special collections (Reference, rare, etc.) may be consulted onsite at the library but are not available for borrowing.

Loan Periods

The loan period for all books is 1 week. All items may be renewed once and are subject to recall.

Items can be borrowed/renewed unless:

- There is a request on the item.
- The maximum renewal limit on the item has been reached.
- There is an outstanding balance on your account.
- Your membership has expired.

Renewals may be granted by contacting the Reference staff prior to the expiration of the loan period.

Requesting items from storage:

Items labeled "Storage" in the SIRC Library Catalog may be requested through the Reference staff. A storage recovery administration fee may be assessed. The borrower will be notified in advance if any fees apply.

Materials located in storage may require 2-3 business weeks for retrieval and delivery to the Resource Centre.

Returning Items:

Return checked-out items to the SIRC Reference staff or to a designated book drop.

Late Materials

An item is overdue if it is not returned or renewed on or before the due date. Overdue items are subject to late charges. The charges will be assessed at \$1.00/day up to a maximum of \$25.00.

Lost Materials

An item is declared lost by SIRC 3 weeks after it becomes overdue. The borrower will be assessed a \$25.00 fine, a \$10.00 processing fee, and the replacement cost of the book. Borrowing privileges will be restored upon receipt of payment.

Damaged Materials

If an item is damaged, damage will be assessed and the borrower may be charged a repair/replacement fee.

Recovery of Fees and Fines

If a member's account reaches \$25.00, an invoice will be sent and borrowing privileges will be suspended until all fees/fines are paid.

Notice

SIRC reserves the right to revoke borrowing privileges at any time.

SIRC reserves the right to modify or cancel services without notice.
